

## PLAN LOCAL D'URBANISME

1 -

Le Plan local d'Urbanisme (PLU) définit les grandes orientations d'aménagement et réglemente toutes les constructions de la ville. C'est le document que l'on consulte lorsqu'on veut construire ou démolir un bâtiment. Il constitue un "projet de ville" qui dessine le futur d'une agglomération pour environ 10 à 15 ans.

2 -

Le Plan local d'Urbanisme est un document stratégique. Il est aussi un document réglementaire: il régit l'évolution des parcelles à travers l'instruction des permis de construire et de démolir. C'est un projet accompagné des règles sur lesquelles se fondent les décisions publiques et privées en matière d'urbanisme.

3 -

L'espace cartographique vous permet de visualiser les documents graphiques du Plan Local d'Urbanisme, sur un secteur géographique ou sur une parcelle, de faire une recherche à l'adresse et de connaître le règlement applicable sur une parcelle cadastrale. Les renseignements d'urbanisme permettent une recherche.

## THE LONDON PLAN

1 -

Mayor Sadiq Khan is driven by one main ambition – to make it possible for all Londoners to have the opportunity to get on in life, to fulfil their potential and to not just survive, but to thrive. To achieve this vision, the Mayor is focusing his time and effort on the most important issues facing our city to improve life for all Londoners.

2 -

Main issues include: building thousands of more genuinely affordable homes to buy and rent; making transport more affordable, better and greener; tackling air pollution to make the air we breathe safe for everyone; making sure Londoners from all walks of life can enjoy arts and culture, ensuring the safety and security of London.

Main issues also include fighting for London's economy – supporting business, protecting jobs, boasting skills provision and increasing the standard of living for all Londoners, encouraging London's diverse communities to come together. Mayor Khan is working hard to make the transport network fair and affordable for everyone.

4–

One of Mayor Khan's top priorities is helping people to lead healthier lives and make more sustainable choices, such as walking and cycling. With London's population expected to rise to 10.5 million in 2041, the Mayor is investing record amounts in London's Underground and rail network to help prepare for population growth.

5 -

Working for London City Hall offers you a challenging and rewarding career, as well as the chance to really improve the lives of Londoners. In return, we offer great working conditions, competitive salaries, generous annual leave, pension schemes, flexible working. Our staff are at the centre of long-term planning and development for our great city.

6 –

The Mayor is taking a range of actions to improve London's environment, setting London on the path to a greener and cleaner future. He believes poor air quality is not only a public health issue but a matter of social justice. He is making it easier for all Londoners, including schools and community groups, to take a more active role in fighting pollution.

7 –

London's air quality is constantly monitored at around 100 different locations. These sites are operated by London boroughs. Despite cuts in most pollutants, levels of PM10 are still too high in some areas of London. We are working hard to reduce concentrations of these pollutants. However, around 30-40% of air pollution comes from outside Greater London.

8 –

The London Plan 2021 is the Spatial Development Strategy for Greater London. It sets out a framework for how London will develop over the next 20-25 years and the Mayor's vision for Good Growth. The Plan is part of the statutory development plan for London. Borough's Local Plans must be in 'general conformity' with the London Plan.
